

Mid-York Color Guard Circuit - Hall of Fame

Nomination Form and Procedure

It is the intent of this award by the Mid-York Color Guard Circuit board and membership to recognize and honor appropriate individuals for their lifetime of dedication to winter guard and the Mid-York Color Guard Circuit. Hall Fame inductees will be recognized at the circuit championships and will also be memorialized on the M-YCGC web page under the Hall of Fame site.

The Process will be as follows:

- Each unit that has been a member for over three years may nominate members to the Hall of Fame Award.
- The chosen nominees will be honored at the M-YCGC Championships and all Hall of Fame members will be invited as our guests to the Championships.
- The M-YCGC Board will appoint a standing committee to select recipients from among those nominated.
- The committee will make recommendation(s) of the final choice(s) to the M-YCGC Board to make a final decision. No more than three persons may be chosen in a given year. If not chosen in a particular year, units may re-nominate persons in a subsequent year.
- This should be a highly regarded honor and an award for a lifetime achievement within the Mid-York Circuit. Therefore, there may be years where no one who is nominated may be appropriate to be chosen.
